## SUSUNAN TEMPAT <sup>M</sup>/ URUTAN TEMPAT <sup>I</sup> Spatial Relations

Spatial relations refers to the relative location of various places, objects or areas: whether something is near or far from something else, whether it is in front or behind, to the north or south, on the left or right side, etc.

Also included in this section are various terms of description such as "straight" or "curved", and location such as "boundary", "intersection", "position" and "surface". Related, as well, are terms which serve to move a person or thing from one place to another. These include terms such as "to head toward", "to cross", "to go via", etc. This last set of terms also requires that movements be expressed in a set chronological order or sequence of time.

These various aspects of spatial order are included in the exercises which follow.
